Temporary 40 mph Speed Limit – Maidstone Road, Charing, Ashford – 19th March 2019

It will be necessary to impose a 40 mph Speed Limit on a section of Maidstone Road, Charing, Ashford planned for 19th March 2019.

This restriction will apply in both directions on Maidstone Road, Charing, Ashford between Hook Lane and Acton Harm, to the extent indicated by signage clearly displayed on site.

The restrictions apply when the relevant 40 mph Speed Limit signage is on site. For a maximum duration of 9 days.

The restrictions are to allow Kent County Council to safely carry out urgent essential carriageway repairs.

This Notice applies when the relevant speed limit signs are placed on site and is valid for a period of up to 21 days.
