MAIDSTONE ROAD, CHARING

TEMPORARY 30 MPH SPEED LIMIT

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Kent County Council gives notice that for the safety of the public and workforce during roadworks, a temporary mandatory speed limit of 30 MPH will be imposed on a section of Maidstone Road, Charing.

The 30 MPH restriction applies in both directions on Maidstone Road, Charing between Hook Lane and access to Acton Farm, to the extent indicated by signage clearly displayed on site.

This takes effect on 7th September 2020 for up to 5 days. The restrictions will be lifted as soon as works are completed and it is safe to do so.

The restrictions have been introduced for the safety of the public and workforce whilst drainage works are to be carried out by Kent County Council.

This Notice applies when the relevant signs and barriers are on site and is valid for a period of no more than 5 days.
