(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2021

To allow Network Rail to carry out drainage improvement works near a railway bridge, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Charing Heath Road, Charing Heath, in the Ashford area.

A closure is currently planned for Sunday 10 October 2021 between 08:00 hours and approximately 20:00 hours.

Charing Heath Road (the section between A20 Maidstone Road and Tile Lodge Road) will be closed in the general vicinity of the railway bridge, to the extent indicated on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via A20 Maidstone Road, Hook Lane, Charing Heath Road, Egerton Road and Tile Lodge Road.
