(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2024

Kent County Council works.

To allow drainage works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Charing Heath Road, Charing.

A closure is planned from 28th February 2024, with estimated completion by 2nd March 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE70711314130-02 - Kent County Council). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Charing Heath Road will be closed from the junction with Pluckley Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage works are undertaken by Kent County Council.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Pluckley Road, Station Road, Maidstone Road, Hook Lane, Charing Heath Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
