(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2024

Openreach works.

To allow replacement pole works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Church Hill, Charing.

A closure is planned from 16th May 2024, with estimated completion by 17th May 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WF9T8R1P-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Church Hill will be closed in the vicinity of Thatch Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement pole works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Church Hill, Vicarage Lane, Egerton Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
