**Openreach works.**

**To allow replacement pole works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Church Hill, Charing.**

**A closure is planned from 16th May 2024, with estimated completion by 17th May 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WF9T8R1P-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Church Hill will be closed in the vicinity of Thatch Cottage, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while replacement pole works are undertaken by Openreach.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Church Hill, Vicarage Lane, Egerton Road and vice versa.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
